Be a student in a behavioral health program and/or a professional actively working with clients/patients.



Requirement 2

Live and work in West Virginia.



Requirement 3

Currently working toward acquiring or increasing a WVCBAPP credential (e.g., ADC, AADC, PS, PRSS).



Requirement 4

Be able to commit to completing the credential of your choosing by or before September 2025.
